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Teachers & Parents – Do you know of a child or young person who excels at art and crafts? **Why not nominate them for Criw Celf?**

Criw Celf is a national scheme that develops more able and talented (MAT) young artists through exciting opportunities. Arts and crafts are fun and an excellent way to meet people with the same interests and to learn new things. As a member of Criw Celf the young artists will:

- Be encouraged to fulfil their potential
- Develop their skills and confidence whilst broadening their horizons
- Work with highly respected professional artists
- Be encouraged to create work of a high standard
- Celebrate the positive aspects of arts and crafts
- Develop their education through a programme that supports the National Curriculum

The membership fee for successful candidates is £42, which includes:

- Six exciting sessions led by a different artist each time, between January and June 2020
- A professional exhibition of works in an art gallery

One of Criw Celf's key messages is to provide equal opportunities to all and there is a bursary for **children who receive free school meals** – please contact us for more information.

As a school you can nominate up to 10 pupils from year 5 to 9. The candidates will need to present a piece of 2D art work, no larger than A3, that reflects their creative skills – they will also need to provide a short paragraph (no more than 50 words) explaining why they would like to join Criw Celf. This along with the completed label below will need to be attached to the back of the work and sent to the address above by the **9th of December, 2019.**

Parents can also nominate their child, but will need a teacher's signature on the form.

Home educated children are also welcome to apply.
