




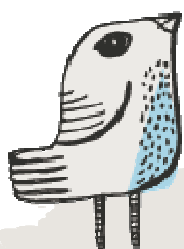

Please attach the label sheet from page three of this leaflet to the artwork submitted. Please note that it is the child's natural ability we need to see when assessing the work. It is important that the child does not receive any help by an adult or artist to create their submission.


An artist panel will select the successful children and we will invite them to join our master-class programme which will start in January 2018, a good start to the new year!

**Children and their parents can self-nominate but a teacher will need to sign a slip to confirm that the child has been identified as a MAT art pupil. Self-nomination details will be announced on our website soon.*
