You will also need to get your child's teacher to sign the label sheet to confirm that the child has been identified as a MAT pupil. Please note that it is the child's natural ability we need to see when assessing the work. It is important that the child does not receive any help by an adult or artist to create their submissions. An artist panel will select the successful children and we will invite them to join our master-class programme which will start in January 2018, a good start to the new year!
